## The Arizona Masterworks Chorale

For over 32 years, **THE ARIZONA MASTERWORKS CHORALE** has thrilled audiences with our devotion to – and love for – excellent choral music. In London, Munich, Carnegie Hall, Washington, DC and Valley-wide, we have been recognized for both the quality of our performances and the breadth of our presentations.

We were affiliated with the Phoenix Symphony from 1979 to 1996. And for ten seasons, the Chorale performed with the Flagstaff Festival of the Arts Orchestra. Other significant venues included the BBC Concert Orchestra at Royal Festival Hall and the Bavarian State Radio Orchestra in Munich. Those concerts were broadcast throughout Europe.

On three occasions, we performed in New York City's Carnegie Hall at the invitation of New York Pops' founder and musical director, Skitch Henderson. One special performance was at the celebration commemorating Carnegie Hall's 100th anniversary. More recently, in May 2004, the Chorale was proud to represent the State of Arizona at the Dedication of the World War II Memorial in Washington, DC. Then, in May 2006, we traveled to Prague, Krakow and Vienna in celebration of the 250th anniversary of Mozart's birth.



MARY ANN DUTTON is the founder of Arizona Masterworks Chorale. She was the director of the Chorale from its inception in 1979 until 2007 and is now Director Emerita. She is Professor of Music Emeritus at Glendale Community College and is affiliated with Rio Salado Community College. Her credentials include study in conducting with Robert Shaw and Margaret Hillis. She received degrees from Arizona State University and did graduate study at Northwestern University. Ms. Dutton has served on the boards of the Arizona Opera Company, the National Opera Association, and the Flagstaff Festival of the Arts. She has directed international tours and conducted the BBC Concert and Flagstaff Festival Orchestras. Mrs. Dutton serves on the Board of Directors of the National Society of Arts and Letters.

**DR. MARK RAMSEY** studied choral music, organ, composition and music theory while at Arizona State University, earning the Doctor of Musical Arts degree. He has participated as an organist, recitalist, and conductor at a variety of music festivals, including the Salzburg Church Music Festival in Austria, the Italian Polychoral Arts Festival in Venice, Italy, and Disneyland's Magic Music Days. He has performed with the Phoenix Symphony and has been an instructor of music at Northern Arizona University. He was inducted into the Pi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society and was a 2004 Co-Recipient of the National Religious Music Week Alliance Award of Distinction. Dr. Ramsey is currently the Director of Music Ministries at First Presbyterian Church, in Mesa and is a past dean on the Central Arizona Chapter, American Guild of Organists.

## Choir Personnel



**DR. WILLIAM A. GLEASON** received a D.M.A. in Choral Music from Arizona State University. He also holds a B.S. in Music Education and an M.M.A. in Choral Conducting from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Dr. Gleason taught vocal and general music for ten years in Illinois at both the junior high and high school levels. After serving as a graduate teaching assistant at Arizona State University for two years, he has taught at Chandler-Gilbert Community College and the Avondale Elementary School District. He is presently teaching music in the Glendale Elementary School District. Dr. Gleason has served as choral director at churches in Illinois and Arizona for over twenty years and conducted the Choralaires of Phoenix men's chorus. As a choral singer, Dr. Gleason has traveled extensively including trips to Carnegie Hall in New York, Mexico City, and Europe on concert tours. He has also served as a clinician and adjudicator in Illinois and Arizona.

**KENT TROSTEL** Kent Trostel has been accompanist for the Arizona Masterworks Chorale since 2000. A native of Ohio, Trostel studied piano at the Idyllwild School of Music and the Arts and holds a degree in Music Performance from the Peabody Conservatory. This past season, Kent accompanied the winner of the Yavapai Symphony Association Young Artist Concerto Competition in performance at the Phippen Western Museum. Kent also performed with the Prescott Center for the Arts Singers for the Veterans Day Annual Concert at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and in concerts at the Prescott Resort and Center for the Arts. Kent recently accompanied baritone Mark Walters and tenor Joseph Wolverton representing Arizona Opera.
