



## Chorale Rehearsals Resume January 16

Rehearsals for our March and May concerts start on January 16 at the regular place and time: Ascension Lutheran Church, Mondays from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. We'll be working straight through March 27, then a couple of weeks off for spring break before resuming on April 17.

Here's the rehearsal schedule Scott has provided:

### January

- 16 Mendelssohn #1 pg 1-7, & #4 pg 17-19 / Langlais reh #28 to end
- 23 Mendelssohn #6 pg 22-33 (Men), #3 pg 13-16 (ladies) / Langlais reh #15 to end
- 30 Mendelssohn #7 pg 34 to end / Langlais reh #9 to 15

### February

- 6 Mendelssohn #7, #3, #6 / Langlais reh #4 to #9
- 13 Mendelssohn clean up / Langlais beginning to reh #4 in Psaume
- 20 Mendelssohn clean up / Langlais clean up

If you've picked up a paper score for Mendelssohn, note that


Scott's markings are included. I have added them to the PDF score posted on the [Chorister News and Information page](#) on our website.
