February

- 6 Mendelssohn #7, #3, #6 / Langlais reh #4 to #9
- 13 Mendelssohn clean up / Langlais beginning to reh #4 in Psaume
- 20 Mendelssohn clean up / Langlais clean up

(Keen observers will note this plan lets us begin rehearsal of


some of the May pieces prior to the March concert.)
