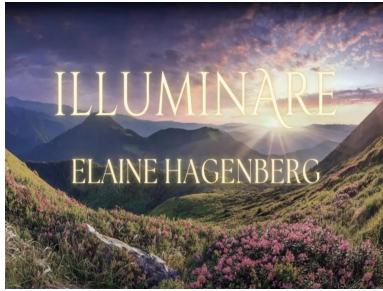
### **Important reminders about the 2024-2025 season**

## November 17: *Illuminare* by Elaine Hagenberg

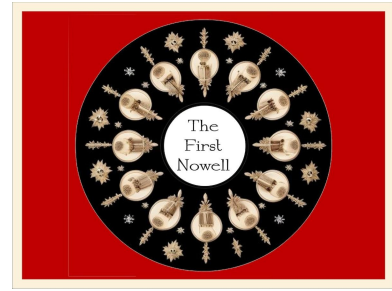

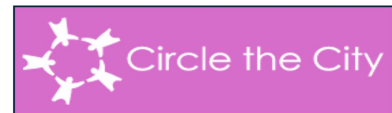


